

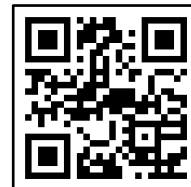





### CCD walkers – Saturday 16 May

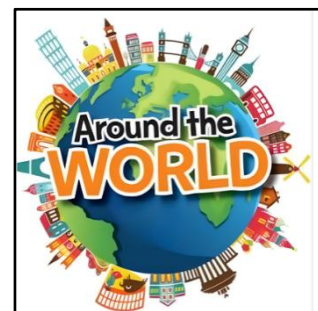
