‘Darkness... with a Glimmer of Hope’

2 Chronicles 21-22: Jehoram and Ahaziah

As we continue our journey through 2 Chronicles, and our consideration of the kings of Judah, we come to Jehoram and Ahaziah; definitely two of the ‘bad’ kings! However, even in the accounts of these two men, we are clearly pointed to the hope that is ours in Christ Jesus, God’s perfect and eternal King.

Read all or part of 2 Chronicles 21 and 22.

1) How are the continuing consequences of Jehoshaphat’s sins seen in Jehoram and Ahaziah? How is this instructive for our own attitude towards sin?

For personal reflection: How do you see your sins hurting others?

2) What does God’s judgment of Jehoram (end of ch. 21) teach us about God’s faithfulness when we rebel?

3) Why is the prospect of the whole royal family being wiped out (22:10) such bad news? What does the preservation of Joash (22:11-12) teach us about God’s determination to redeem? How does Joash point us to what God has done in Christ?

Take the opportunity now to turn some of the things you have discussed into prayer for one another.
