

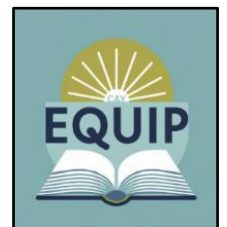
Do join us for our **Morning Services at 9:15 and 11:15am**, when **Gareth Mitchell** will be preaching and continuing our series in Ephesians.

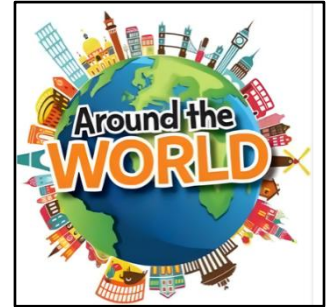
Church Membership
