Pray for churches in different contexts:

- Pray for churches in city situations. For example Inner city churches.
- Pray for churches in town situations. For example Dunstable
- Pray for churches in rural situations. For example villages, farming communities, remote areas.

How to pray for the churches:

- They would boldly preach the word of God in a culture increasingly opposed to it.
- That God would enable great unity within the local churches that promote the gospel message.
- They would be able to connect with their local communities and understand the needs of their own community...
- In that this would fuel evangelistic outreach and practical aid to the people living in their communities.

CRANFIELD PARISH CHURCH

- Please pray as we plan and strategise to get a **20s-40s discipleship group** off the ground. We've seen more in this age range join us over the last 2 years and we really need to invest in their discipleship beyond Sundays.
- Please pray for our ministry to **Cranfield University students**. The new term is about to begin, and we will hold an evangelistic welcome meal for international students on **October 13th**.
- Please pray that our four values of: **bible**, **prayer**, **holiness**, **and evangelism** will become more and more embedded throughout the life of the whole church family.
