We are well here in Limuru as we praise God for His grace among us. Here are a few pointers to help you pray for us.

Praise God that our church plant is gaining momentum; we are now consistently averaging 30 adults and 20 children every Sunday. Visitors and seekers are coming along. Please pray for faithful gospel witness.

Praise God also for our recent first children's Bible club, when we registered over 90 children despite it being rainy and wet. Many of them are from the area and a few are now coming to church, plus some parents checking us out! On the back of this, we are planning another holiday Bible club in November, when we have a long school break. Pray that this will work well.



We are doing a mini-series in John 6, where Fidel is preaching six sermons. It's proving helpful to the congregation, especially for our newer friends, some of whom aren't clear on the gospel and how we can be saved. We'll then do a series in Ruth in October, preached by one of the gifted men in the church. Pray that God will build us up through the preaching of His Word.

We had a bring and share lunch and a members' meeting on Sunday 28th September, when we gave an update on how things have been going so far and shared our plans for the next few months, which include introducing a midweek Bible study and prayer meeting, as well as weekly growth group meetings. We also gave a financial update and presented a proposal to lease a piece of land next to where we meet. Please pray that the Lord will bless our future plans.

We are grateful to the Lord for the opportunities He gives us to serve the Church in Brazil and also for all the blessings we receive as a result of our partnership with APCB and Nutra. Greetings from Serbia! Prayer updates unite us in the Lord's Kingdom. We are thankful for your prayers; and we are also praying for you as Gareth and Phil take on the reins in leading Christ Church Dunstable!

We returned to Serbia from our trip to the US and Canada at the end of August; and it took us some time to adjust to the different climate and time zone. It was a very intense nine-

week trip; we put a lot of miles on our car and visited almost all of our ministry partners. During the trip, Jan developed some health issues and went to our doctor in Canada to get some antibiotics, but there was no time to rest and his health worsened. After returning to Serbia, Jan contacted several doctors and obtained effective medication, as well as receiving suggestions to change his diet. Slowly, he is feeling better, but is still far away from his normal condition. Please pray for Jan and his health going forward.



In September, we made a week-long street evangelistic tour to central Serbia, visiting two large towns, each with a population of around 60,000. Only in one of those towns is there a small Christian group of ten believers. We were blessed there, because a lot of people came to our stand and, for the first time, we ran out of Bibles and New Testaments! Please pray for each person who took a Bible or other literature, that the Holy Spirit will work in their heart and they will come to know the Lord. Please also pray for our forthcoming October outreach.

On 1st October, Radio Sinaj celebrated its first year online. We are grateful to the Lord for this ministry; and also thankful to several local Christians who have helped us record new programmes and manage the ministry. The online space is very competitive; please pray for us to effectively target new listeners, especially those who need the Saviour.

Luke & Larissa (Riss) Crowter Silver Street Community Church, London



Please join us in giving thanks to our steadfast God for 10 years of faithfulness to Silver Street Community Church, here in Edmonton in north London.

Since 1911, Tanners End Mission had worshipped Jesus in the building that is now our home. 15 years ago, that church had dwindled and a handful remained. This handful bravely asked for help and eventually the doors were closed in the hope of re-opening a new church plant a few years later.

In September 2015, Silver Street Community Church was born, starting with a team of 19 adults and 12 children. The Lord has been at work!

We now have 79 adult members and we've baptised 25 people. The Lord has raised up two new elders and five new deacons; and He has sent two families on mission to West Africa. We've had the privilege of being a sending partner in a new church plant; and of being part of the training of fifteen theological students, as well as eight trainees with our in-house Discipleship Training Scheme.



The Lord has provided financially year on year, allowing us not only to do a costly roof replacement and purchase a manse, but also to employ a part-time children's and youth worker alongside the pastor, as well as a volunteer women's and welfare worker.

The Lord has grown us in numbers, maturity and unity across great diversity. We planted a church in Edmonton to reach Edmonton; and it's been thrilling to see the Lord continue His mission of bringing His kingdom to the nations. We've worshipped alongside people from over 65 different countries and had the privilege of sharing the good news of Jesus with thousands of people in our local community.

Not to us, not to us – but to HIS Name be the glory (Psalm 115:1). Please join us in praising the Lord for His faithfulness; and please pray for overflowing fruitfulness and resilient faithfulness in the decade ahead.
